Competition age: Under 20 years, men and women – EJU / IJF affiliated countries
(born between January 1st, 1993 and December 31st, 1997)

Duration of fights: 4 minutes Golden score: 2 minutes

Competition System: The inscription by Jumas system is an obligatory. The competition will be held according to the rules of EJU / IJF
With a double repechage system on 3 tatami.
In case of category with low numbers of competitors:
2 entries: better of 2 fights, if 1-1 the third match will decide.
3,4,5 entries: one pool competition system (round robin)
6 and more entries: Double repechage competition system
Blue and white judogis are obligatory
All judoka must compete in IJF approved judogis.
The top 4 competitors in each category according to the EJU Junior Ranking list will be seeded

Weight categories: Men: -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg
Women: -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, +78kg

Transfer: The transfer from Budapest Airport to the Registration and the Tournament Hall will be provided by the organiser.

**Inscription:**1. First Entry (numerical)

National federations are requested to send the the numerical entry form not later than 16th of June 2012

2. Final Entry (nominal)

National federations are requested to send the the nominal entry form not later than 9th July 2012

According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is 9th July 2012, Monday. Participants without a valid EJU Jumas membership have to pay a € 30 penalty per participant. Jumas membership must then be ordered through the federation. Judogi: Blue & White Judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule. All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website.

Back Numbers

Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2010 EJU / IJF back number will no longer be accepted. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com

Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks.

The SPONSOR part - if needed – will be given to the delegations during the registration process, and athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the backnumber.

In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the costs of the backnumber of all cancelled athletes.

Coaching

All coaches must fully adhere to the Code of Conduct for Judo Coaches. Forbidden is coaching throughout the contest except for between *Matte* and *Hajime* (the coach is only allowed to speak to his athlete between *Matte* and *Hajime*)

Dress Code:

Draw: jacket suit and tie

Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes, or jacket suit with tie

For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie.
