| Inscriptions & Deadlines | The NUMERICAL before February 17 th The NOMINAL before March 16 th The JUMAS entry before April 9 th The Flight SCHEDULE before March 16 th In order for an athlete to obtain points for the EJU Ranking List, his / her weight category should have participants from at least 2 different countries. If this is not the case, the competition can still be held, according to the organiser's decision. If, by the nominal deadline, there are less than 2 countries inscribed in any weight category, the organizer is obliged to inform immediately the NF concerned. According to EJU rules: Jumas inscription is obligatory. Participants must be registered in Jumas, otherwise they will face a late entry fee of € 30 per participant. The deadline is Monday of the week of the Tournament 9 th Abril 2012. Jumas membership ordered on site will cost € 30 per card. Jumas system for clubs will be launched in February; we will post the link on the EJU Website. |
| Transfers | The Portuguese Judo Federation assures the transportation of the delegation members inscribed by the official entry list from Official Hotel and Sportshall . The transfer from Lisbon International Airport to Coimbra (200 km) must be booked together with your inscription and will have an additional cost of 20 euros per person/per journey. These conditions are for transfers on Friday (until 7 pm) and departure on Monday (Competition) and Thursday (training camp). Transfer on other periods may be providing on request. Please contact organization. |
| Accreditation | The Accreditation will take place at the Hotel D. Luís, according to the attached Official Programme. |
| Draw & Competition System | The draw will take place after the accreditation at the Hotel D. Luís, according to the attached Official Programme. Double repechage competition system Competition systems with less than 5 competitors will be played in Round Robin (more details are in the handbook on the EJU website) No Seeding. (Only separation by nations) <u>EJU / IJF Dress Code (Draw):</u> jacket suit with tie. |
| Coaches Conduct & Dress Code | The coach is responsible for his athlete's conduct from entering the competition venue until leaving it, before and after each contest. Coaching will be strictly limited to communication with athlete, tactical advice, encouragement, instructions in unexpected situations, as injury, etc. The coach will remain seated on his chair throughout the contest and will leave the mat together with his athlete. The coach should make sure that the competitor leaves the mat immediately; otherwise the whole team will be suspended. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Draw meetings: jacket suit with tie• Elimination rounds: national track suit with trousers reaching down to shoes.• For the final block program (TV time): jacket suit with tie. The following are forbidden at any time: shorter trousers, undressed upper body, sleeveless T-shirts, any kind of head caps and cover, jeans, sweaters or similar sports unrelated dress, flip-flops. |
| Weigh-in | The weigh-in will take place in the morning on each day of the event, at the OFFICIAL HOTELS, according to the attached Programme. Athletes are not allowed to weigh-in naked. Boys must wear at least underwear and girls at least underwear |



| Refereeing | The Referee Meeting will be at the Sport hall in the morning of the first day of competition (9.30 am), according to the attached Programme. Each delegation should bring an IJF/ Continental licensed referee. <u>Special Refereeing Rules for Cadets:</u> - Application of kansetsu waza is prohibited: The referee will stop the action if any of the athletes try to apply kansetsu waza and there will be no penalty. If tori applies kansetsu waza a second time, he is given direct hansoku make and he is not allowed to continue the competition. - Application of shime waza is allowed: An athlete who has lost consciousness due to shime waza is not allowed to continue the competition. |
| Back Numbers | Numerical Inscriptions must be sent in about 2 months before. The participating federation should advise how many athletes will be participating. Each competitor taking part in the EJU events is obliged to have on the back of his Judogi the official 2011 EJU / IJF back number. The 2011 Back Number version is obligatory. The participating athlete / federation is responsible for ordering and sewing of the the back number, which must be the official EJU / IJF one. It should be ordered from www.mybacknumber.com . Production and delivery takes around 4 weeks. Athletes without the appropriate back number will be out of the competition, No reserve Judo Gi will be available. The SPONSOR part (if needed) will be given to the head of delegation during registration, and the athletes can stick it themselves using the special glue on the back number. In case the participating federation sends fewer athletes than registered in the numerical entry, the federation will be charged the cost of the back number of all cancelled athletes.  Blue & White Judogi is obligatory. Judogi control according to Sokuteki rule. All Judoka must compete in IJF Approved Judogi. The detailed information about the Judogi is available on the EJU website. |
| Insurance | The organizers of the event and the Portuguese Judo Federation (or any of its officials or members) will not be liable or responsible for arising accident or damage during participation (competition and training sessions) or traveling in connection with this competition. Each delegation must assume full responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities and assistance repatriation for their competitors and officials during their stay in Portugal. |
