Like every four years, a few weeks break after the outstanding Olympic Games allowed the world champions to take a little rest. The first major world event of the beginning of the year will be, for most of the teams, THE PARIS GRAND SLAM (Tournoi de Paris Ile de France) which will take place on the 9th and the 10th of February 2013.

This tournament, which starts the new 2013-2016 Olympiad, will host the encounter between the experienced and the new athletes, and will open the battle for the leadership for the next years in each category.

WARNING: NO service will be provided by the organizers to delegations which don't want to be accommodated in official hotels. These delegations will have to give us a phone number and email address to transmit all important information.

Hotel reservations are made ONLY through the Organizer on a first come first serve basis, on the following web site: www.parisgrandslam.com. Lasts hotel reservations without surcharge (number of people) must be made **before December 12th, 2012 (included)**, by a bank transfer of 50% of the total amount. If this first payment is not received on time, organizers can't ensure any room, and if they can, 50% of the total amount will have to be paid immediately from December 13th, 2012 to January 4th, 2013 (included). To book definitely the hotel, full payment must be received before January 4th, 2013 (included) (for Bank transfer account please refer to the below information). If payment is made after this date a surcharge of 10% will be levied upon the total payable amount. NO exceptions will be made. All bank fees and bank transfer costs are to be paid by the participation federation.

Cancellation fees: before December 12th, 2012 (included), full refund. From December 13th, 2012 to January 4th, 2013 (included) a penalty of 40% of the total amount. After the January 4th, 2013 any cancellation of rooms or no-show will result in 100% of the charge of the hotel costs. Cancellations of the rooms cannot be made at the check-in. Injuries, visa problems or sickness are not valid reasons for cancellation of rooms. ”

5. INSURANCE

Each National Federation is responsible for its competitors (the control of non-pregnancy as well as the gender control are placed under the responsibility of the National Federations) and must assume all responsibility for accident and health insurance as well as the civil liabilities for their competitors and officials, during the **Tournoi Paris Ile-de-France – GRAND SLAM 2013**.

The organizer of the **Tournoi Paris Ile-de-France – GRAND SLAM 2013** and the IJF will not be responsible for any insurance related to the above mentioned matters. Nevertheless the National Judo Federation staging the **Tournoi Paris Ile-de-France – GRAND SLAM 2013** shall take all necessary actions to provide insurance coverage against civil liability for the entire duration.

The organizer of the **Tournoi Paris Ile-de-France – GRAND SLAM 2013** and the IJF has no liability for any claims of injury, illness or death arising out of the participation and traveling in connection with these events.



6. NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS

Each Country: Maximum 2 competitors per weight category

Organizing Nation: Maximum 4 competitors per weight category

Note:

- a. Competitor can only be entered in one weight category.
- b. Only entries of National Judo Federations – IJF Members will be accepted



7. DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION

Start of reservation:	November 12th, 2012
First Entry (entry by number):	December 12th, 2012 (included)
Payment of 50% of the reservation until:	December 12th, 2012 (included)
Final hotel reservation (number of people):	December 12th, 2012 (included)
Full payment of the reservation :	January 4th, 2013 (included)
Final visa request (MUST with Passport Copies):	January 19th, 2013 (included)
Travel information:	January 25th, 2013 (included)

Final Entry (entry by names): The registration must be done with the IJF online registration system at <https://www.judobase.org> until **January 19th, 2013 23:59 CET!**

Nations missing the registration deadline will not be allowed to start.
No exceptions will be made!

All competitors, coaches and officials must be entered in time. After the deadline no additional persons can be added.

NOTE: It will be allowed to replace already registered coaches or officials; competitors only in the case of an injury.

8. CONTROL OF ENTRIES AND ACCREDITATION

The control of entries and issuing of accreditation cards will take place at **Palais Omnisports Paris-Bercy, in the "Salon d'honneur" (Gate 35)**

on Tuesday 7th February 2013 from 12:00 PM to 9:00 PM

on Friday 8th February 2013 from 09:00 AM to 11:59 AM

At least one team official must attend in time to confirm the entries of all athletes and officials with his/her signature. A delayed appearance or no-show at control of entries may result in the exclusion of all participants from the draw and the event. In case of unforeseen delay of arrival the Federation must contact immediately the organizer and the IJF registration team (registration@ijf.org)

An accreditation card with photograph will be issued to competitors, officials and media. This accreditation card must be carried at all times. Passports or photocopy of passports from all competitors must be available on request.

Number of accreditations for officials:

- a) 1 – 4 competitors : 4 officials
- b) 5 – 9 competitors : 6 officials
- c) More than 10 competitors : 7 officials

Extra accreditation for delegation members 100 Euro for 2 days.



9. COMPETITION RULES

a. Competition will be conducted in accordance with the latest IJF SOR, IJF Refereeing Rules and IJF Anti-Doping Rules. Especially refer to the New Uniform IJF Competition System with quarter final / last 8 / repechage.

b. Weight categories:

Men: -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg

Women: -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, -78kg, +78kg

c. Duration of contest: MEN & WOMEN: Five (5) minutes (real time).

The “Golden score” with no time limit. Referees’ decision is cancelled.



10. REFEREES

Referees are appointed by IJF Refereeing Commission.



11. WEIGH-IN

a. The weigh-in will be carried out in accordance with the IJF SOR, Article 16.

b. The athlete’s official weigh in will be scheduled the day before the competition at 7:00 pm. A weigh in will be operated the morning of the competition (for testing), during the Judogi control, prior to the first fight.

Unofficial weigh-in: 6:30 PM to 6:59 PM (the day before)

Official weigh-in: 7:00 PM to 7:30 PM (the day before)

c. Weigh-in will be held in **Novotel Paris Bercy: 85 rue de Bercy, 75012 Paris, France (0,1 km from the venue).**



12. DRAW

a. The draw will be conducted at **2:00 PM on 8th February. (Place: Palais Omnisports Paris-Bercy (POPB): 8 boulevard de Bercy, 75012 Paris, France; Gate (35)).**

b. Each National Federation must send a delegate to attend the Draw; a maximum of three (3) delegates per National Federation (2 officials and 1 athletes’ delegate) will be authorized.

c. The top 16 among the entered competitors in each weight category will be seeded according to the World Ranking List.

Remark: At least one team official must attend the accreditation at **7th February 2013 between 12:00pm and 9:00pm** or **8th February between 9:00am to 11:59am** in order to confirm the delegation. Without this confirmation in time a nation will not be put into draw and not be allowed to start.



14. JUDO GI CONTROL

a. **Approved judogi:** Competitors should wear an IJF approved judogi supplied by one of the following manufacturers: Greenhill, SFJAM NORIS, DANRHO, MIZUNO, Double D Adidas, HAYAKAWA, Fighting Film, Budo Sport AG, ESSIMO, MATSURI B.V.

b. **Judogi Control:** It will be operated with a sokuteiki by IJF Education Commission prior each fight. Judogi must have an IJF Official Label "APPROVED JUDO GI" with an optical code which cannot be falsified. The label will be controlled with an optical lamp. Each of the competition clothing articles (jacket, trousers and belt) must have an IJF official label.

c. **Backnumber:** Each competitor is obliged to have sewn on the back of his judogi a backnumber bearing his surname and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation. The backnumbers must be fixed horizontally and centered on the back of the judogi. They must be placed at a distance of 3cm from the bottom of the collar.

d. **Advertising:** Competitors must carry on the back of their jacket the IJF and organizer dedicated sponsors of the event. Advertising on the judogi must be in compliance with the IJF regulations. Refer to Guidance of Judogi Control Document published on 15.06.2011.

e. **National Emblem:** Athletes can have their national emblem on the left front part of the jacket within a space of 100cm².

NOTE: It is the responsibility of the judoka to comply with the IJF regulation rules.

A control weigh-in (for testing) will be operated the morning of the competition, during the judogi control, prior to the first fights.



15. PARTICULAR RULES FOR WOMEN

Female contestants shall wear under the jacket either, a plain white or off-white tee-shirt, with short sleeves, rather strong, long enough to be worn inside the trousers, or a plain white or off-white leotard with short sleeves. The white Tee-shirt should be round necked. No marking can be visible when the judogi is done up. All other regulations must be adhered to.



16. COACHING

Code of behavior of coaches as defined in the Sports and Organization Rules, Annex 4 will be strictly observed, inclusive the Dress Code.

- Coaches are not allowed to give indications to the competitors while they are fighting.
- Only during the pause time (after mate), coaches will be permitted to give indications to their athletes.
- After the pause is finished, and the fight continues (hajime), coaches will have to keep silent again.
- If a coach doesn't follow these rules, he can be expelled from the competition area.
- If the coach persists with his behavior from outside the competition area, he could be penalized.



17. ANTI-DOPING CONTROL

The anti-doping control will include in each category:

- a. the winner of the category
- b. one of the three other medal winners

As per draw (for b) carried out in accordance with the Anti-doping Rules and the Sports and Organization Rules of the IJF.

The competitors have to report to the Doping Control Station not later than 60 min after signed Notification form, in writing by the Physician mandated by the IJF must follow the indications leading them to the check station. In that period of 60 min, it is allowed for the athletes to take part in the awarding ceremony and to fill their commitments to the press. They are constantly accompanied by persons from the organization from the time they receive their notice until they reach the check station. A person of their choice (team doctor, coach, trainer, delegation head...) may accompany the competitors. The draw is made during the competition before the start of the finals block.



18. AWARDS AND PRIZES (IN TOTAL USD154,000)

The organizer shall provide for presentation:
A certificate of participation for each participant.

Medals, diplomas and prizes:

First place: Gold medal and **US\$ 5,000**

Second place: Silver medal and **US\$ 3,000**

Two Third places: Bronze medals and **US\$ 1,500** for each



19. TRAINING FACILITIES

The training area of Palais Omnisports Paris Bercy will be available for delegations on Wednesday 6th, February from 2:00 pm to 8:00pm and on Thursday 7th and Friday 8th, February 2013, from 10:00am to 8:00pm.



20. VISA

The Organizer is happy to help any country with obtaining visa for athletes and officials. For nations, who need VISA to enter in France, please send the Organizer as soon as possible (**latest January 19th, 2013 (included)**) list of participants according to visa application form with full names, sex, passport numbers, date of birth, and positions (MUST send together with scanned Passport Copies according to the relevant updated requirement of **French** Government).



21. LAND TRANSPORT

The Organizer will provide free of charge transportation for competing delegations: Transfer to and from **Roissy Charles de Gaulles / Paris Orly airports or Paris' train station from/to hotel**, and bus service to and from competition venue.



22. FUNDAMENTAL PRINCIPLE

All National Federations, officials, coaches and athletes participating in the **Tournoi Paris Ile-de-France – GRAND SLAM 2013** have to respect and accept the authority of the IJF officials, the Statutes, the Sports and Organization Rules, the Refereeing Rules of the International Judo Federation, as well as the IJF Antidoping Rules. According to the IJF Rules and SOR Provisions (point 23.8), individuals deemed to have acted against the IJF, its principles or purposes shall be subject to suspension or expulsion from the event and/or cancellation of their accreditation cards.



23. ATTENTION VERY IMPORTANT

The competitors wearing their white judogi (no shoes) will stand behind the podium according to the following order 2,1,3,3. Every competitor having won a medal has to attend the ceremony and receive his medal in person. If a competitor is absent during the awarding ceremony for no valid reasons he will lose the right for the medal. It is strictly forbidden for competitors on the podium to bring national flags or the similar identification other than the one represented in the regular manner on their equipment. Any demonstration of religious, political, personal or commercial sign is prohibited and so is wearing a cap or any other head cover.

24.2 Participants

Seniors : women and men - Registrations have to be done by national federation.

24.3 Accommodation and Catering

The organization proposes to delegations 3 packs:

Pack 1: Training Camp + Accommodation + Full-board Rate: 390 euros/person

Accommodation: shared twin at hotel F1 Paris Porte de Châtillon (or similar)

Catering at the training venue (Institut du Judo)

Accommodation in single room possible for coaches at the rate of 480 euros/person

Pack 2: Training Camp + Full-board

Rate: 300 euros/person

Catering at the training venue (Institut du Judo)

Accommodation and transport costs are supported by the national federation

Pack 3: Training Camp only

Rate: 160 euros/person

Accommodation, catering and transport costs are supported by the national federation

Warning: The hotel capacity for the Training Camp is limited. Rule of first come, first served will be applied.

24.4 Rights of participation

The regulation of the European Judo Union says that you should be ready to pay following rights of participation:

- 30 euros /person for European federations;

- 100 euros /person for non-European federations.

Warning: These costs are not included in rates of Packs for accommodation and catering.

24.5 Registration and payment
